



Illegal riders at Fairy Hill quarry Altyre Estate Forres.

I received today a telephone call from Will Cumming landlord of Altyre Estate who has provided ground for 6 Scottish Enduro Championship rounds over the last 3 years.

Will is himself a keen off roader and has in the past competed at Lossiemouth.

However, he is very alarmed at the illegal riding taking place at Fairy Hill, with several riders being there most weekends and having built jumps and other features within the area. Worse still is that his padlock has been cut twice now by bikers to allow vehicle access.

If this continues he will shut the quarry off by other means and deny us, Highland Enduro Club access for official events on his land.

We have no alternative land for our Enduro's so continuation of illegal riding there will be another step in killing off our sport.

The estate has been in contact with the Police on this matter and they also will take action on riders caught on this land.

I have been in contact with the SACU Chairman, Sandy Mack, and I confirm that any SACU licence holder caught illegally riding there will be refused any further licence and refused entry to any SACU event.
